The tables are offered in a variety of heights and shapes to accommodate varying settings and applications.

The seating collection is perfectly complemented by sixfivezero_CO tables, designed by Coalesse’s in-house design team, and in a wide array of shapes, sizes and unique finish options. Table shapes include round, square and rectangle, available in dining, counter and bar heights, balancing both the philosophy and aesthetic of the seating collection to create an extensive portfolio of solutions for today’s collaborative spaces.
